

**17th JUDICIAL CIRCUIT ANNOUNCES ON LINE SCHEDULING
FOR UNIFORM MOTION CALENDAR**

Effective April 6, 2009 all hearings for uniform motion calendar hearings in the (13) general civil divisions of the circuit court may be set via a web based scheduling system. The System can be accessed from Courts web site at:

Click on “On Line Scheduling” Button

The on line scheduling system allows the user to set and cancel any hearing on motion calendar. The user is also able to confirm the hearing has been set by reviewing the judge’s motion calendar for any particular day. Additionally practices and procedures for every judge in the civil division are posted on each judge’s web page.

To use the system, attorneys must have an active email address with the Florida Bar website. Attorneys may register additional users under their bar identification.

Local Rule 10 A and all Florida Rules of Civil Procedure remain the same

The on line system is simply an electronic way of self-scheduling motions. All motions must have been filed before scheduling any hearing and a courtesy copy of the Notice of Hearing and Motion must be mailed to the Judge’s Judicial Assistant. *Please indicate on all notices of hearing the matter was scheduled on line.*
