ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AS JUVENILE DELINQUENCY CASE DISTRIBUTION

(a) Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215(b)(3) states the chief judge shall “develop an administrative plan for the efficient and proper administration of all courts within that circuit.”

(b) In accordance with the authority vested in the chief judge by Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is ordered:

(1) The Clerk of Court, effective immediately, shall assign the juvenile delinquency cases in the following percentages:

Division JA	25%
Division JB	25%
Division JC	25%
Division JD	25%

(2) The Clerk of Court shall randomly assign any and all cases in as equal a distribution as possible to the divisions as set forth in paragraph 1.

(3) This Administrative Order modifies Administrative Order II-06-F-4C as to distribution of cases. All other provisions of Administrative Order II-06-F-4C, except for judicial assignment, remain in full force and effect.
