**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
REGARDING DISTRIBUTION OF COUNTY TO  
CIRCUIT COURT CRIMINAL APPEALS**

---

- (a) Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215(b)(3) states the chief judge shall “develop an administrative plan for the efficient and proper administration of all courts within that circuit.”
- (b) In accordance with the authority vested in the chief judge by Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is ordered:
- (1) Commencing January 14, 2008, upon the filing of a Notice of Appeal from a county court criminal case, the Clerk of Court shall randomly distribute the case to a circuit criminal division.
  - (2) The Clerk of Court shall not assign any appeal to an individual judge but shall assign it only to a circuit criminal division. The only circuit criminal divisions to receive appeals are FA, FB, FC, FD, FE, FF, FG, FH, FI, FJ, FK, FN, FP, FR, FZ, FW, FX, and FY.
  - (3) Any and all pending appeals assigned individually to Judge Ilona Holmes or Judge Susan Lebow or to divisions FO and FT shall be immediately randomly reassigned to circuit criminal divisions FA, FB, FC, FD, FE, FF, FG, FH, FI, FJ, FK, FN, FP, FR, FZ, FW, FX, and FY.
