**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER ESTABLISHING  
DISTRIBUTION OF FAMILY CASES**

---

(a) Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215(b)(3) states the chief judge shall “develop an administrative plan for the efficient and proper administration of all courts within that circuit.”

(b) In accordance with the authority vested in the chief judge by Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is ordered effective January 14, 2008, the following shall govern the distribution of family cases:

(1) The Clerk of Court shall randomly assign cases in the following percentages:

35	14.28	4.75
36	14.28	4.75

38	14.28	4.75
40	14.28	4.75
41	14.28	4.75
42	14.32	4.75
44	0	66.75

(2) Those cases which are defined as family cases and/or pro se cases shall be governed by prior Administrative Orders.
