ORDERED that:

There will be a Civil and Criminal Duty Judge to handle emergency and after hour assignments according to the attached schedule (s).

The Duty Judge shall be available from 8:30 A.M. Friday until 8:30 A.M. Friday of the following week, and should make his/her telephone number available to the duty officer of the Broward County Sheriff's Office. If a judge leaves office, his/her replacement will cover the assignment of the judge he/she is replacing. In the absence of the Chief Judge and an Appointed Acting Chief Judge, the Civil Division Administrative Judge shall act as Chief Judge. In the absence of the Chief Judge, and appointed Acting Chief Judge and the Civil Division Administrative Judge, the Criminal Division Administrative Judge shall act as Chief Judge.
