DIVISION ASSIGNMENT OF
WRITS OF HABEAS CORPUS

In accordance with the authority vested in the Chief Judge by Rule 2.050 of the Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, it is:

ORDERED as follows:

1. All "Civil" Writs of Habeas Corpus regarding persons incarcerated as a result of a criminal division case are to be randomly assigned within the General Civil Division.

2. All "Family" Writs of Habeas Corpus regarding parents incarcerated as a result of failure to pay child support in a family division case are to be assigned to the family division Judge who entered the particular child support order.

3. All "Family" Writs of Habeas Corpus regarding a child as a result of a child custody/placement order in a family division case are to be assigned to the family division Judge who entered the particular child custody order.
