In accordance with the authority vested in the Chief Judge by Rule 2.050, Florida Rules of Judicial Administration it is

ORDERED as follows:

1. When restitution is ordered by the Court and is subsequently collected by the Department of Corrections or the Clerks Office and the victim who is to receive this court ordered restitution is unable to be located, these funds shall be disbursed to the State General Revenue Fund.

2. Such Disbursement should clearly designate these funds as "Unclaimed Restitution" because of the unknown whereabouts of the victims.

3. Should this victim later be located or come forward, they shall make a claim by sending a written request to the Office of the Attorney General, Division of Victim Services, Department of Legal Affairs, The Capitol, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-1050.
