WHEREAS, the Broward County jail population is at or near the cap; and

WHEREAS, there are individuals in custody for technical violations of probation or community control; and

WHEREAS, the jail population may be reduced if the individuals awaiting hearing on the technical violations of probation or community control are heard in an expeditious manner,

NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with the authority vested in the Chief Judge by Florida Rule of Judicial Administration Rule 2.215, it is

ORDERED as follows:

1. The Clerk of Court shall determine for all divisions of the Circuit Criminal Division all technical violation of probation and community control cases wherein the defendant is incarcerated at a jail facility operated by the Sheriff of Broward County. The term technical violation of probation and community control cases shall be only those cases where the defendant is charged with a violation of the terms of his or her probation or community control and no additional charges are pending against the defendant.
2. The Administrative Judge for the Criminal Division shall hear all pending in-custody technical violation of probation and community control cases as set forth in this order.

3. The Clerk of Court shall provide notice to all individuals entitled to notice that calendar call shall be held on Friday, June 1, 2007, at 1:30 p.m. before the Administrative Judge for the Criminal Division at Room 4900 of the Broward County Courthouse, 201 S.E. Sixth Street, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33301. The term calendar call is used to reflect the appearance of the State, defense attorney, and defendant to determine the status of the pending case and when it will be set for hearing.
4. At the time of calendar call on June 1, 2007, the Administrative Judge for the Criminal Division shall schedule the date and time of the hearing for each pending in-custody technical violation of probation and community control cases. The Administrative Judge for the Criminal Division shall hear these cases the week of June 4, 2007 and the week of June 11, 2007.
