Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, it is

ORDERED that:

The State Attorney's Office Appeals Division shall upon this authority, be allowed to remove court files from the Office of the Clerk of Courts for the purposes of preparation of Response to all defendant's Motions for Post Conviction Relief, Florida Statutes 3.850 and/or 3.800. The Clerk of Courts shall retain custody of all court files until such time as the Office of the State Attorney shall require the court file in order to perfect their response to motions of this type. The Office of the State Attorney shall establish a procedure, whereby the file shall be properly returned to the Clerk's Office at the conclusion of the proceedings.
