In accordance with the authority vested in the Chief Judge by Rule 2.050, Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, it is

ORDERED that:

The Criminal Blitz of 1995-1996 will be managed as follows::

CALENDAR CALL

Beginning November 27, 1995, In-court Clerks for the felony divisions shall set all trials on in-custody defendants which are scheduled after January 1, 1996, for calendar call ON JANUARY 8,9,10, 1996 before the following Judges:

DIVISIONS FE,FJ,FL,FM,FV TO JUDGE SPECHLER, COURTROOM 510

DIVISIONS FA,FB,FC,FD,FF TO JUDGE SEIDLIN, COURTROOM 540

DIVISIONS FG,FH,FI,FK,FQ TO JUDGE LYNCH, COURTROOM 500

The above divisions are dedicated to holding Calendar Call on the above three days commencing at 9:00 A. M.

During this Calendar Call defendants will be given the option of entering a plea or going to trial during the Blitz period.

Defendants desiring to enter into a plea negotiation will be sent to the following judges for that purpose only in the courtrooms designated:

COURTROOM FOR PLEAS: JUDGE SPECHLER'S CASES ASSIGNED TO JUDGE STREITFELD 336

FOR PLEAS: JUDGE SEIDLIN'S CASES ASSIGNED TO JUDGE MOE 562

FOR PLEAS: JUDGE LYNCH'S CASES ASSIGNED TO JUDGE FEINER 563

Defendants requesting a trial will be randomly assigned a division by the In-court Clerk and set for the trial Blitz January 16, 1996, at 9:30 A. M. A notice will be generated by the clerk in the courtroom and given to the defendant.

Existing Felony Division Judges shall direct their judicial assistants to set **NO CASES** for the Blitz period. The only matters which may be set in a felony division at that time are emergencies which shall be heard at 8:30 A. M. by the felony division judge. Trials before these Blitz Divisions shall commence at 9:30 A. M. At that time judges shall conduct their own calendar call and prioritize their cases for trial over the Blitz period.

On January 16th jurors will be available at each existing felony division courtroom at 10:30 A. M. for voire dire.

Any non-felony division judges participating in the Blitz will have jurors available at 9:30 A. M. in the jury assembly room. Judges are requested to promptly return any excused jurors to the jury assembly room for recycling. Any Circuit Civil, or County Civil Division not participating in the Blitz will have jurors available for trial only after Blitz division juror requests have been accommodated.

All requests for continuance and demands for speedy trial will be heard by either Judge Ross or Judge Grossman on a rotating basis in courtroom 417. Any requests for these hearings will be coordinated by Judge Grossman's Judicial Assistant at extension 7759.

BACKUP COVERAGE FOR BLITZ PARTICIPANTS

Any Civil, Family, Probate and County Court Judges participating in the Blitz shall conduct their regular motion calendars at 8:30 a. m. to 9:30 a. m. each day of the Blitz. Trials for these divisions to be set for a future date.

Judges who are not participating directly in the Blitz will be teamed with a participating Blitz judge for the purpose of setting aside time on their dockets to conduct any special set hearing (not just emergency hearings) during the periods listed:
