ORDERED that:

All witness subpoenas served on all witnesses for criminal cases scheduled for trial for the period of the Criminal Blitz as defined by this Court's Administrative Order No: III-95-C-10A, and any revisions thereto, said period running inclusively from January 16, 1996 to February 2, 1996, shall remain in full force and effect for said time period until each witness has either appeared pursuant to said subpoena or has been excused from appearing pursuant to said subpoena any any witness who has been properly served in accordance with law or by agreement who purposefully fails to appear after notice to do so may be subject to penalties for contempt of court.
