ORDERED that:

Effective Immediately;

1. On weekdays, when court is regularly in session, all detained juveniles and their accompanying paperwork are to be present in Magistrate's Courtroom 241 no later than 1:15 P.M.
2. On days when court is not regularly in session, (weekends and holidays), all detained juveniles and accompanying paperwork are to be present in Magistrate's Courtroom 241 no later than 8:00 A.M.; furthermore, these juvenile cases, if present, are to be processed first, prior to adult magistrate proceedings.
3. This order shall remain in effect until December 31, 2002.
