The schedule was presented to the Court in order that violators of said statutes may, should they choose to do so, plead guilty to and dispose of the violations by payment of the designated fines and costs at the office of the Clerk of the Court for Broward County, Florida.

Unless a mandatory court appearance is required, any person charged with a violation of any one or more of the attached State Statutes may, in lieu of contesting such charge in the County Court in and for Broward County, Florida, execute a written Appearance, Plea of Guilty or Nolo Contendere and Waiver as to any such charge and pay the designated fine, court costs and assessments for law enforcement training specified below, at the office of the Clerk of Court. If a citation is marked "Mandatory Appearance", the Clerk is not authorized to accept a written plea or payment of fine, and the person charged shall be required to appear personally in court to answer to the charge.
