PAYMENT OF JURORS SERVING
IN SATELLITE COURTS

In accordance with the authority vested in the Chief Judge by Rule 2.050 of the Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, it is
ORDERED that:

Those jurors who serve on trial juries in any satellite court shall be paid mileage, in addition to the daily fee of \$10.00, from their homes to the satellite court in accordance with a form to be executed by the juror showing the total mileage consumed during said trial. Such form, which shall be created by the Clerk of the Circuit Court, will be given to the in-court clerk at the Satellite in the case that said juror was serving and the form will be furnished to the in-court clerk at the end of such service.

The Clerk of the Circuit Court shall cause as soon as possible a check to be sent to all such jurors for the total of the daily fees and mileages.
