REFERRAL IS NEEDED.**

MOTION CALENDAR: NON-EVIDENTIARY HEARINGS

Fridays at 8:45 a.m. and it is held in Chambers with check in at Room 560.

For all Motions scheduled, including re-notices, please submit a copy of the notice of hearing, the motion including all supporting documents, a copy of your online scheduling confirmation, and Order of Referral to General Magistrate Boven's chambers 5 business days prior to the hearing date.

HEARING OFFICER/CHILD SUPPORT CALENDAR:

Motions for temporary child support and motions for contempt/enforcement for nonpayment of child support and any other matter that relates only to child support and can be completed within 15 minutes may be scheduled on the child support calendar. You do not need to call first. If you require more than 15 minutes, please call before scheduling.

Hearing Officer/Child Support Calendar is held on Wednesday mornings 2 times per month. Please consult the online Child Support Calendar System for specific dates and times.

You must have an Order of Referral to Hearing Officer by the day of your hearing but you can schedule your hearing prior to receiving the signed referral.

For all Motions scheduled, including re-notices, please submit a copy of the notice of hearing, the motion including all supporting documents, a copy of your online scheduling confirmation, and Order of Referral to Hearing Officer Boven's chambers (room 560) 5 business days prior to the hearing date.

SPECIAL SET HEARINGS AND TRIALS:

Please call the Magistrate's assistant to set a special set hearing and/or Trial. Before you call for a hearing date, you must obtain an Order of Referral from the assigned Judge. When calling the Magistrate's office please conference in opposing counsel's assistant so that the date and time can be coordinated.

Please submit a copy of the Notice of Hearing, Motion and Order of Referral to Magistrate Boven's chambers within 7 days after scheduling the hearing.
