

The one-year program, funded by the Florida legislature, that established a special foreclosure unit in the 17th Circuit ended on June 30, 2011. As a result, The Foreclosure Case Management Unit was disbanded. All residential mortgage foreclosure hearings will continue to be heard in courtrooms 4150 and 14160 – cases are not being re-distributed amongst the civil division.

Beginning July 11, 2011:

- All pro se litigants setting hearings must go in person, with a copy of the motion that was filed with the Clerk of Courts, to Room 780 in the main courthouse.
