## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AS TO DIVISION FQ CASES

- (a) Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215(b)(3) states the chief judge shall "develop an administrative plan for the efficient and proper administration of all courts within that circuit."
- (b) In accordance with the authority vested in the chief judge by Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is ordered:
- (1) The Clerk of Court shall equally distribute any and all appellate active, pending, and closed cases in Division FQ among all Circuit Criminal Divisions.
- (2) The Clerk of Court shall randomly reassign any and all non appellate active, pending, and closed cases in Division FQ to Divisions FO and FT in as equal a distribution as possible.
- (3) The Clerk of Court shall not assign any cases to Division FQ as of September 4, 2007.
- (4) Administrative Order 2007-7-Crim is vacated.
