## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER DIRECTING THE CLERK OF COURT TO REASSIGN DIVISION 64 CASES

- (a) Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215(b)(3) states the chief judge shall "develop an administrative plan for the efficient and proper administration of all courts within that circuit."
- (b) In accordance with the authority vested in the chief judge by Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is ordered:
- (1) The Clerk of Court, effective January 14, 2008, shall randomly reassign any and all active, pending, or reopened cases in Division 64 in as equal distribution as possible to Divisions 60, 61 and 62.
- (2) If companion cases are inadvertently transferred to different divisions, the Clerk of Court shall, upon written notice from either the assigned judge or attorney for a party, transfer the companion case(s) with the higher case number to the division with the lowest case number.
- (3) Administrative Order IV-07-A1-B shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this Administrative Order or any other Administrative Order as to distribution of cases and judicial assignments.
