- (1) Applications for Appointment as Guardian and Disclosure Statements submitted by professional guardians must include the Professional Guardian Annual Checklist which is attached Exhibit A.
- (2) Applications for Appointment as Guardian submitted by non-professional guardians must include the Non-Professional Guardian Checklist which is attached as Exhibit B.
- (3) This order shall vacates and supersede Administrative Order IV-03-A-24.
