AMENDED ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AS TO RESIDENTIAL FORECLOSURE

- (a) Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215(b)(3) states the chief judge shall "develop an administrative plan for the efficient and proper administration of all courts within that circuit."
- (b) In accordance with the authority vested in the chief judge by Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is ordered:
- (1) The Clerk of Court shall ensure that all open and pending foreclosure case court records are physically located at the Broward County Courthouse, 201 S.E. Sixth Street, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33301.
- (2) The Clerk of Court shall deliver foreclosure case court records to judicial case managers upon request.
- (3) The Clerk of Court shall reflect the disposition of foreclosure cases as indicated on the final disposition form filed by the plaintiff or as directed by a judge or judicial case manager.
- (4) The Clerk of Court, from July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2011, shall reflect the additional designation of SJ after the division number of all residential foreclosure cases.
- (5) This Administrative Order shall take effect on July 1, 2010.
