**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER ASSIGNING
ALL CIRCUIT JUDGES TO DEPENDENCY**

- (a) Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215(b)(3) states the chief judge shall “develop an administrative plan for the efficient and proper administration of all courts within that circuit.”
- (b) Florida Rule of Juvenile Procedure 8.305(b)(14) requires judges assigned to dependency cases hear shelter hearings.
- (c) §39.013, Fla. Stat., vests jurisdiction with the circuit court for dependency proceedings.
- (d) In accordance with the authority vested in the chief judge by Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is ordered:

All circuit judges are assigned as alternate dependency judges.
