- (1) Kathleen Pugh, Trial Court Administrator, is hereby authorized to execute any and all contracts on behalf of the circuit and her execution of same shall bind the circuit as if signed by the chief judge commencing as of August 1, 2011.
- (2) Kathleen Pugh, Trial Court Administrator, is delegated the authority to authorize and approve travel expenditures for the judges, general magistrates, hearing officers and judicial employees for the circuit commencing as of August 1, 2011.
- (3) This Administrative Order vacates and supersedes Administrative Order 2007-8-Gen on August 1, 2011.
