**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER DESIGNATING
RECORD NEWSPAPER**

(a) Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215(b)(3) states the chief judge shall “considering available resources, ensure the efficient and proper administration of all courts within [this] circuit.”

(b) §50.0711, Fla. Stat., requires the designation of a record newspaper by a majority of judges in the circuit. The judges previously voted on this matter but the Broward Review has a successor in interest.

(c) In accordance with the authority vested in the chief judge by Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is ordered:

(1) The Daily Business Review, successor in interest to the Broward Review, is the designated record newspaper for those matters set forth in §50.0711, Fla. Stat.

(2) This Administrative Order replaces and supersedes Administrative Order I-88-A-2.
