ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER ASSIGNING CRIMINAL TRUANCY PETITIONS

- (a) Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215(b)(3) states the chief judge shall "develop an administrative plan for the efficient and proper administration of all courts within that circuit."
- (b) There are limited resources to meet the needs of parents charged with truancy and the distribution of the cases in all county criminal divisions is inefficient.
- (c) In accordance with the authority vested in the chief judge by Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is ordered:
- (1) The Clerk of Courts shall transfer all open and active cases filed pursuant to \$1003.24 or \$1003.27, Florida Statues to Division MM.
- (2) The Clerk of Courts shall assign any new case filed pursuant to §1003.24 or §1003.27, Florida Statues, as of the date of the Administrative Order to Division MM.
- (3) The Clerk of Courts upon the reopening of a closed case filed pursuant to \$1003.24 or \$1003.27, Florida Statues, shall assign the case to Division MM.
