- (b) Florida Rule of Judicial Administration Rule 2.215(b)(5) authorizes the chief judge to “designate a judge in any court or court division of circuit or county courts as administrative judge of any court or division to assist with administrative supervision of the court or division.”
- (c) In addition to administrative judges, there is a need for chairpersons to assist the administrative judges with administrative duties for other courts or divisions within the circuit.
