## AMENDED ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER APPOINTING DESIGNEE TO HEAR MOTIONS FOR EXCESS FEES

- (a) Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215(b)(3) states that the chief judge shall, "considering available resources, ensure the efficient and proper administration of all courts within [this] circuit."
- (b) Section 27.5304, Florida Statutes, authorizes the Chief Judge to designate a single judge to preside over motions for excess fees filed by private court-appointed counsel.
- (c) In accordance with the authority vested in the Chief Judge by Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is **ORDERED:**
- (1) Judge Peter M. Weinstein is appointed to preside over all pending and newly-filed requests for excess fees filed by private court-appointed counsel.
- (2) This Administrative Order vacates and supersedes Administrative Order 2013-22-Gen.
