## **ORDERED** as follows:

- 1. The Clerk of Court upon entry of this Administrative Order shall manually assign seventy percent (70%) of the drug court cases to Division FN and shall manually assign thirty percent (30%) of the drug court cases to Division FR until further order of this Court.
- 2. The Clerk of Court shall determine the number of cases assigned to Divisions FN and FR between January 17, 2007 and the date of entry of this Administrative Order for compliance with the allocation of cases for the two (2) divisions. The Clerk of Court shall report his findings to the Criminal Division Administrative Judge within thirty (30) days of entry of this Administrative Order.
