In accordance with the authority vested in the Chief Judge by Rule 2.050, Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, it is ORDERED that:

- 1) Defendant's who have active pending DUI(s) and are subsequently arrested for a new DUI, shall be assigned to the division of the pending DUI(s) with the lowest case number.
- 2) Defendant's who are on probation for DUI and are subsequently arrested for a new DUI, shall have the new DUI case assigned to his/her probationary Judge.
- 3) In the event part one (1) and two (2) of this Order were to conflict, the new cases shall be assigned to the probationary Judge.
- 4) In the event that the Defendant either has a pending DUI case or DUI probation at a Satellite Courthouse, and is subsequently rearrested for a new DUI and demands trial by jury thereupon, the pending cases shall be consolidated with the new DUI and transferred to this Central Courthouse together.
