In accordance with the authority vested in the Chief Judge by Rule 2.050, Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, it is hereby;

1. ORDERED that all Circuit Criminal Judges are assigned to temporary duty in the County Court of Broward County, Florida, for the purpose of hearing and disposing of any Criminal Misdemeanors, Criminal Traffic matters, Violations of County or City Ordinances and Traffic Infraction(s) or any other case(s) where jurisdiction would normally fall within County Court that comes before them in conjunction with a pending felony matter, and they shall have all the power and jurisdiction of a County Court Judge in said case(s).

2. The Clerk of Court is directed to file with the Circuit Court all misdemeanor(s), traffic infraction(s), etc. along with the felony charge(s) arising out of a same incident.
