**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REGARDING NONPROFESSIONAL
GUARDIAN EDUCATION**

(a) Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215 (b) (3) states the Chief Judge “shall, considering available resources, ensure the efficient and proper administration of all courts within [this] circuit.”

(b) In accordance with the authority vested in the Chief Judge by Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is hereby **ORDERED**:

(1) Pursuant to section 744.3145, Florida Statutes, which provides the minimum number of hours nonprofessional guardians are to receive in guardianship training through courses approved by the Chief Judge of the Circuit, the approved courses for the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit are those as provided by The Broward County Bar Association, St. Petersburg College, Rainy Day Disability Resources, Inc., and Guardianship Training & Support Services.

(2) This Administrative Order vacates and supersedes Administrative Order IV-05-A-25.
