APPOINTING SUBSTITUTE COUNTY CANVASSING BOARD MEMBERS FOR 2018 ELECTIONS

- (a) Section 102.141, Florida Statutes, requires the Chief Judge to appoint substitute county canvassing board members in the event a member is unable to serve or is disqualified.
- (b) In accordance with the authority vested in the Chief Judge by section 102.141, Florida Statutes, it is hereby **ORDERED:**
- (1) If a county canvassing board member is unable to serve or is disqualified, the following qualified electors are appointed to serve as substitute canvassing board members: all Broward County Judges and all Seventeenth Judicial Circuit Judges.
- (2) The substitute canvassing board members are appointed for any and all actions required by law as to elections occurring in 2018.
- (3) The substitute canvassing board members are authorized to sign any and all documents as required by law with regard to the elections occurring in 2018.
