**VACATING ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2019-85-GEN**

(a) Pursuant to Article V, section 2(d) of the Florida Constitution, and section 43.26, Florida Statutes, the chief judge of each judicial circuit is charged with the authority and the power to do everything necessary to promote the prompt and efficient administration of justice.

(b) Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215(b)(3) states the chief judge “shall, considering available resources, ensure the efficient and proper administration of all courts within [this] circuit.”

(c) Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215(e)(3) requires the chief judge to perform an annual review of all local administrative orders to ensure that none conflict with supreme court or local rules.

(d) In accordance with the authority vested in the chief judge by Article V, section 2(d) of the Florida Constitution, 43.26, Florida Statutes, Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, and to promote public safety amidst the current public health emergency, it is hereby **ORDERED**:

(1) Administrative Order 2019-85-Gen is hereby **VACATED**.
