ACTIONS FOR OBTAINING ALTERNATE PROOF OF MOTOR VEHICLE OWNERSHIP

(a) Pursuant to Article V, section 2(d) of the Florida Constitution, and section 43.26, Florida Statutes, the chief judge of each judicial circuit is charged with the authority and the power to do everything necessary to promote the prompt and efficient administration of justice.

(b) Florida law requires a purchaser of a motor vehicle to obtain a court order directing the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles to issue a certificate of title to the purchaser when such individual does not receive title of the motor vehicle at the time of purchase.

(c) The implementation of uniform procedures and form petitions and orders is necessary to ensure the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles is properly made a party to and noticed for these proceedings as to ensure the swift administration of such cases.

(d) In accordance with the authority vested in the chief judge by Article V, section 2(d) of the Florida Constitution, 43.26, Florida Statutes, Florida Rule of General Practice and Judicial Administration 2.215 it is hereby **ORDERED**:

(1) Any person seeking a court order directing the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles to issue a certificate of title for a motor vehicle must complete and file with the Clerk of Court the following documents:

- a. Complaint for Declaratory Relief (Vehicle Title Transfer), Attachment "A"
- b. Affidavit for Vehicle Title Application, Attachment "B"

(2) The Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles, and any other person who may be able to claim ownership over the subject motor vehicle, including the

prior owner, if any, must be named as defendants and the petitioning party must ensure proper service of process on said defendants.

(3) The assigned trial judge shall decide whether an affidavit of diligent search and inquiry shall be required in any particular case.
