**ASSIGNING JUDGE TO GRAND JURY
OCTOBER 2021 TO MARCH 2022**

- (a) Florida Rule of General Practice and Judicial Administration 2.215(b)(3) states that the chief judge shall “considering available resources, ensure the efficient and proper administration of all courts within [this] circuit.”
- (b) Florida Rule of General Practice and Judicial Administration Rule 2.215(b)(4) authorizes the chief judge to assign judges to courts and divisions.
- (c) In accordance with the authority vested in the Chief Judge by Florida Rule of General Practice and Judicial Administration 2.215, it is hereby **ORDERED**:
- (1) The Honorable Thomas J. Coleman, Circuit Court Judge, is hereby designated to preside over the Grand Jury for the period of time October 1, 2021 to March 31, 2022.
