Administrative Order No. 2026-07-CO

ESTABLISHING LOCATIONS FOR HEARING OF TRAFFIC INFRACTIONS

(a) Pursuant to Article V, section 2(d) of the Florida Constitution and section 43.26, Florida Statutes, the chief judge of each judicial circuit is charged with the authority and power to do everything necessary to promote the prompt and efficient administration of justice.

(b) Florida Rule of General Practice and Judicial Administration 2.215(b)(3) states the Chief Judge “ensures the efficient and proper administration of all courts within [this] circuit, considering available resources.”

(c) The Broward County Board of County Commissioners has established four (4) courthouses in Broward County. The Broward County Judicial Complex a/k/a the Central Courthouse is located at 201 S.E. Sixth Street, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33301. The North Regional Courthouse is located at 1600 West Hillsboro Boulevard, Deerfield Beach, Florida 33442. The South Regional Courthouse is located at 3550 Hollywood Boulevard, Hollywood, Florida 33021. The West Regional Courthouse is located at 100 North Pine Island Road, Plantation, Florida 33324.

(d) The allocation of traffic infraction cases between the four (4) courthouses is necessary for utilization of the satellite courthouses for the convenience of the public and alleviates the parking congestion at or near the Central Courthouse at peak court business hours.

(e) In accordance with the authority vested in the Chief Judge by Article V, section 2(d) of the Florida Constitution, section 43.26, Florida Statutes, and Florida Rule of General Practice and Judicial Administration 2.215, it is hereby **ORDERED**:

(1) **All non-camera-related traffic infraction hearings shall be filed and conducted as indicated below:**

- (2) Any State of Florida agency, department, division, or office not reflected in paragraph 1 shall file its initiating pleadings documents at the South Regional Courthouse. All judicial action for the matters filed pursuant to this provision shall occur at the South Regional Courthouse.
- (3) Any Broward Sheriffs Office District not reflected in paragraph 1 shall file its initiating documents at the West Regional Courthouse. All judicial action for the matters filed pursuant to this provision shall occur at the West Regional Courthouse.
- (4) **Effective March 2, 2026, all camera-related traffic infraction hearings shall be assigned and conducted as follows:**
- (a) All new camera-related traffic infraction cases, including red light and school zone camera traffic infraction cases shall be assigned to and heard at the Central Courthouse.
- (b) All pending Town of Davie school zone camera traffic infraction cases shall be assigned to and heard at the Central Courthouse.
- (c) All pending red light camera traffic infraction cases assigned to the South Satellite as of March 1, 2026 shall remain assigned to the South Satellite through disposition.

- (d) All pending red light and school zone camera traffic infraction cases assigned to the North Satellite as of March 1, 2026 shall remain assigned to the North Satellite through disposition.
- (5) The Clerk of Court shall provide a Deputy Clerk at all traffic infractions hearings and trials.
- (6) In all non-camera-related County Court Civil traffic infraction cases in which a party files with the Clerk a written objection to a remote appearance in court proceedings, the Clerk of the Court shall transfer the case to Division MXD.
- (7) In all camera-related County Court Civil traffic infraction cases in which a party files with the Clerk a written objection to a remote appearance in court proceedings, the Clerk of the Court shall transfer the case to Division MW.

This Administrative Order vacates and supersedes Administrative Orders 2017-17-CO and 2023-1-CO (Amendment 1).
