**CORRECTED ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER VACATING
COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDERS**

- (a) Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215(b)(3) states the chief judge shall “considering available resources, ensure the efficient and proper administration of all courts within [this] circuit.”
- (b) Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215(e)(3) requires an annual review of administrative orders to ensure that none conflict with supreme court or local rules.
- (c) A review of the County Administrative Orders indicates a need to vacate administrative orders that are in conflict with statutes, supreme court rules, or no longer required for judicial proceedings.
- (d) In accordance with the authority vested in the chief judge by Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is ordered
