ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AMENDING
MENTAL HEALTH COURT ADMINISTRATIVE
ORDER III-06-S-1A

(a) Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215(b)(3) states the chief judge shall “develop an administrative plan for the efficient and proper administration of all courts within that circuit.”

(b) In accordance with the authority vested in the chief judge by Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is ordered:

- (1) The provision for a certificate of eligibility as set forth in I.B.1.c. is vacated.
- (2) The defendant at the time of the hearing on the motion for downward departure shall present the court with possible placement options. If the motion is granted the court shall provide the defendant’s placement options to Court Projects to determine if the placements options will accept the defendant and advise the court. The court shall make the final determination of placement.
- (3) All other provisions of Administrative Order III-06-S-1A are not vacated and shall govern the proceedings in the Mental Health Court Subdivision with the Circuit Criminal Division.
