**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER VACATING GENERAL ADMINISTRATIVE
ORDER I-91-B-6A**

(a) Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215 (b) (3) states that the chief judge “shall, considering available resources, ensure the efficient and proper administration of all courts within [this] circuit.”

(b) Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215 (e) (3) requires the Chief Judge to perform an annual review of all local administrative orders to ensure that none conflict with supreme court or local rules.

(c) A review of General Administrative Order I-91-B-6A indicates that it is no longer required.

(d) In accordance with the authority vested in the Chief Judge by Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is hereby **ORDERED**:

(1) Administrative Order No. I-91-B-6A is **VACATED**.
