**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REGARDING GUARDIAN ADVOCACY
TRAINING COURSE**

(a) Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215 (b) (3) states that the chief judge “shall, considering available resources, ensure the efficient and proper administration of all counts within [this] circuit.”

(b) In accordance with the authority vested in the Chief Judge by Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is hereby **ORDERED**:

(1) Pursuant to section 394.4598 (4), Florida Statutes, the Guardian Advocacy Course as developed by the Department of Children and Families is hereby designated as the approved course to fulfill the Guardian Advocacy training requirement.

(2) This Administrative Order vacates Administrative Order IV-97-A-17.
