FIRST APPEARANCE
CRIMINAL HISTORY INFORMATION

In accordance with the authority vested in the Chief Judge by Rule 2.050, Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, it is,

ORDERED that all law enforcement agencies, as defined by F.S. Chapter 943, shall transport with all prisoners who are to be booked into the Broward County Jail, a copy of his/her their NCIC/FCIC criminal history. The criminal history record shall be attached to the arresting officers' probable cause affidavit, and be made a part of the court documents available to the Magistrate Judge at First Appearance hearings. Inasmuch as the criminal history record was obtained by a criminal justice agency for a criminal justice purpose, F.S. Sections 943.053(1) and 943.054, such record is not available for public dissemination. F.S. Section 943.053(4). Subsequent to the First Appearance hearing the NCIC/FCIC information shall not be retained in the case file(s), but delivered to the Office of the State Attorney.
