IMPLEMENTATION OF
NEW GUARDIANSHIP ACCOUNTING,
PLAN AND INVENTORY FORMS

In order to provide effective and efficient review of guardianship accountings, plans, and inventories so that the Court can more adequately protect those incapacitated persons who are placed in guardianships to accumulate information to enable it to more effectively promote appropriate case management, and ensure compliance with statutory requirements for the review of said filings pursuant to Chapter 744 of the Florida Statutes, the Court has revised the forms currently required in this Circuit. The new forms, as well as instructions, are available at no cost to guardians and attorneys for use in this Circuit, and can be utilized on any PC (they are not MAC compatible) without any other software required. The forms and instructions will be available for downloading after November 15, 2000 at www.17th.flcourts.org and www.browardbar.org.

In accordance with the authority vested in the Chief Judge by Rule 2.050, Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, it is hereby:

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that as of November 15, 2000 the revised forms will be made available and the Clerk of this Court may accept them for filing. Effective January 1, 2001

all guardianship accountings, plans, and inventories shall only be filed on the attached forms. The Clerk shall provide timely notice of this requirement to all acting guardians.

This Order shall supersede Administrative Order Number IV-98-A-22 dated November 5, 1998.
