ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REGARDING JUVENILE DELINQUENCY DETENTION HEARINGS DURING CHRISTMAS AND NEW YEAR'S COURT HOLIDAYS

- (a) Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215 (b) (3) states the Chief Judge "shall, considering available resources, ensure the efficient and proper administration of all courts within [this] circuit."
- (b) Florida Rule of Judicial Administration Rule 2.215 (b) (4) authorizes the Chief Judge to assign judges to courts and divisions.
- (c) In accordance with the authority vested in the Chief Judge by section 43.26, Florida Statutes and Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is hereby **ORDERED**:
- (1) Juvenile delinquency detention hearings scheduled to occur during December court holidays are to be presided over by the assigned holiday first appearance magistrate judge.
- (2) Juvenile delinquency detention hearings scheduled to occur during the week of December court holidays are to be presided over by the first appearance magistrate judge assigned for that time.
- (3) Juvenile delinquency detention hearings scheduled to occur on the New Year's Day court holiday are to be presided over by the assigned holiday first appearance magistrate judge.
- (4) Juvenile delinquency detention hearings scheduled to occur during the week of the New Year's Day court holiday are to be presided over by the first appearance magistrate judge assigned for that time.
