**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER VACATING ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
2008-2-Crim**

(a) Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215(b)(3) states the Chief Judge “shall, considering available resources, ensure the efficient and proper administration of all courts within [this] circuit.”

(b) Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215(e)(3) requires the Chief Judge to perform an annual review of all local administrative orders to ensure that none conflict with supreme court or local rules.

(c) A review of Administrative Order 2008-2-Crim (Establishing Procedures for County Court In Custody Defendants) reveals that it is no longer required.

(d) In accordance with the authority vested in the Chief Judge pursuant to Article V, section 2(d) of the Florida Constitution, section 43.26, Florida Statutes, and Florida Rule of Judicial Administration 2.215, it is hereby **ORDERED**:

(1) Administrative Order 2008-2-Crim is **VACATED**.
