**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER TEMPORARILY
APPOINTING GEORGE ODOM, JR., CIRCUIT COURT JUDGE AS
COMMISSIONER**

Pursuant to the May 15, 2026 order of the Fourth District Court of Appeal, the Honorable George Odom, Jr. is assigned to act as Commissioner in Case Number 4D2026-0677, Lower Tribunal Case Number 19-006905CF10A. Consistent with the order of the Fourth District Court of Appeal, the Commissioner shall make findings of fact as to whether petitioner timely requested counsel to file a notice of appeal and to provide a recommendation as to whether a belated appeal should be granted. The Commissioner shall file a report and recommendation with the Fourth District Court of Appeal no later than sixty (60) days from the Fourth District Court of Appeal's May 15, 2026 order. The parties shall have ten (10) days from receipt of the report to file objections with the Fourth District Court of Appeal as to the Commissioner's findings of fact. If no objections are filed within the time allowed, the commissioner's findings and recommendation will be adopted by the Fourth District Court of Appeal.
